What types of presentations will be featured in the virtual meeting?

The program has not been altered significantly. You will still receive quality content with eight tracks: Wireless/Spectrum, Security, IT/OT, Utility of the Future, Infrastructure/Utilisite, Broadband, Emerging Technology, and Policy. We will have the main keynotes, pre-conference training, summits, and 101 classes. All sessions will be on-demand so that you have every opportunity to take part in the great content.

Will there be concurrent sessions during the virtual meeting?

Yes, this program will have concurrent sessions. With our virtual program, you can access these sessions on-demand **for six months** following the event, so you can be sure not to miss any of the excellent session content.

Will Professional Development Hours (PDHs) be available?

Yes, with 12 hours of summits and 48 hours of education sessions, your conference registration entitles you to up to 60 hours of education credits.
